

ORDINANCE NO. O-19-25

RESCINDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE §927.20 AND ADOPTING NEW CODIFIED ORDINANCES IN CHAPTER 927 REGARDING CHARGES AND PAYMENTS FOR TEMPORARY (HYDRANT) METERS

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington has a provision for allowing the installation and removal of temporary water service; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to rescind and replace certain sections of Chapter 927, Water Rules and Regulations, of the Codified Ordinances, in order to better-define the City's policy on temporary water service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 927.20 Charges and Payment for Temporary Service of Chapter 927, Water Rules and Regulations, of the Codified Ordinances is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. That Council hereby adopts a new Section 927.20 of the Codified Ordinances

927.20 TEMPORARY (HYDRANT) METERS

- a. Water used through temporary meters shall be billed at the same rate paid at the bulk water hauling station at the Wilmington Water Plant. The rate shall be charged in accordance with W.C.O. 929.06.
- b. The fee for installation of a temporary hydrant meter shall be as follows:

Meter size	Application Fee (Non-refundable)	Monthly Fee	Deposit
5/8"	\$25.00	\$15.00	\$250.00
Larger than 5/8"	\$25.00	\$25.00	\$750.00

- 1) A monthly fee will be charged after the first thirty (30) days of use. The monthly fee will be prorated for any partial month use, based on the day the meter is returned.
- 2) The deposit and application fee must be paid in separate transactions.
- 3) The deposit will be returned in full if all the following conditions are met:
 - a. The meter is returned in satisfactory condition as determined through inspection by Water Plant personnel.
 - b. All fees for the temporary service have been paid in full.
- c. An application for service shall be completed and will be approved in the same manner as other utility services. The application shall require a signature and shall include the name of person completing the application, the applicant/business name (if applicable), billing address, service address, and mobile phone number.
- d. The Water Department shall have access to the meter for reading on the first business day of each month. Meters not made available for reading on the first business day of the month may be subject to a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee for each subsequent trip necessary to obtain a reading.
- e. Temporary (hydrant) meters for water service will be provided only when available. Availability of meters is not guaranteed.

Section 3. That each and every section of Chapter 927, Water Rules and Regulation, of the Codified Ordinances, except those in sections identified and amended in Section 2 of this ordinance, are hereby ratified and republished and incorporated herein by reference as though fully rewritten herein.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be effective from the earliest period allowed by law.


