

AUTHORIZING ADVERTISEMENT AND CONTRACT FOR HAULING OF LIME SLUDGE FROM WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized to advertise to contract for the hauling of lime sludge from the Water Treatment Plant in accordance with specifications to be promulgated therefore and within the appropriation therefore, the total cost to exceed the sum of \$25,000.00.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to contract for the hauling of lime sludge with the best and lowest bidder therefore, within the appropriation for such purpose, after advertisement for such bids for not less than two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, due to impending contract deadlines and the need to maintain uninterrupted services, and accordingly, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.


