

RESOLUTION NO. R-16-11

DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY, TO WIT: VEHICLES VALUED AT MORE THAN \$1000, AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAID VEHICLES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the following described personal property, to wit: a 1959 Ford 600 tractor identified by Serial Number 5864137, 1996 F-150 Truck VIN FTEF15N9TLB46600, and a John Deere Aero-vator identified by Serial Number E00270G866563 are no longer necessary for municipal purposes and that it is in the best interests of the City to sell said vehicles and conditions set forth hereinafter:


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned vehicles to the highest and best bidder as is permitted pursuant to O.R.C. 721.15; and

Section 2. That the Director of Parks and Recreation shall set a reserve price on the vehicles and include the reserve price in the aforementioned advertisements.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Wilmington, Ohio.
