TAX LEVY CERTIFICATION RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The City of Wilmington, Ohio has authority pursuant to **Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(A)**, to provide funds for Current Expenses, and


WHEREAS, the amount of the taxes raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the City of Wilmington, and it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose set forth in R.C. 5705.19(A); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the Council of the City of Wilmington requests that the Auditor of Clinton County, Ohio, certify to the Council the total current valuation the City of Wilmington and the dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by the passage of An ADDITIONAL LEVY pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(A) in the amount of 2.0 mills (20 Cents (\$0.20) for each one-hundred dollars of valuation). The purpose of said LEVY under said Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(A), for the purpose of current expenses of the subdivision. Revised Code Section 5705.19(A); for five (5) years commencing with calendar year 2017, tax duplicate years, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020 for the necessary requirements to the extent permitted by Revised Code Section 5705.19(A); and said Council anticipates placing said levy on the ballot in the election to be held November 8th, 2016

Section 2. That the rules requiring the reading of this ordinance in its entirety on three separate days are hereby suspended upon a vote of three-fourths of the members of council, pursuant to R.C. 731.17(A)(2)


