AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE UPDATED CLINTON COUNTY
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT HAZARDOUS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Emergency Management Agency, in conjunction with elected officials and public safety personnel of the various local government entities, has reviewed the Clinton County Hazardous Mitigation Plan and finds that the plan meets the requirements of the state and federal guidance requirements; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio Emergency Agency and the Federal Emergency Agency has directed the various Ohio counties to have and keep updated every five years a Hazardous Mitigation Plan and to forward the updated plan to the state and federal agencies for review and approval; and




Section 2. That this Resolution shall be effective from the earliest period allowed by law.


