ORDINANCE NO. O-19-14

ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF CERTAIN STREETS, ALL UTILITIES, UTILITY EASEMENTS AND UTILITY HARDWARE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That all streets, alleys and public ways, including all sanitary sewer and water lines continuing in the right of way thereof, as identified in the following record plans, attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A,":

Section 2. That all of the utility easements as defined on said plats, including the sanitary sewer easements, storm sewer easements, water line easements are hereby accepted for public use, provided that the Grantor will not construct upon, above, or sub-adjacent thereto, within the limits of the above-described easements, any building or improvement other than those presently in existence and replacements thereof, or otherwise in any manner interfere with the use of the easements without the express written consent of the City of Wilmington, Ohio.

Section 3. That the utility lines, lift stations, pumps, hydrants, manholes, catch basins, and all other appurtenances presently located in said easement areas are hereby accepted for public use.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be effective from the earliest period allowed by law
