March- Projects & News

March has us thinking Spring and working on city clean-up efforts. John Garrison of the M & R Department, and I have been able to target problem areas that require litter removal as well as trimming trees and bushes back from the right-of-way. Along with some community service members, we were able to complete 3 large projects and 2 smaller projects, with plans for more as the weather and time allow.

City Property/Vacant Lot Clean-Up Projects

East Locust Street- Clearing back overgrowth, honeysuckle, and litter removal.



North Spring Street- Clearing back overgrowth, honeysuckle, and litter removal around sidewalk, ravine, and railings.



Paris Avenue -Removal of dumped items, clearing of trees, honeysuckle, and sediment.



Hawley Avenue Sidewalk - Removal of overgrowth and litter growing onto the sidewalk on a vacant lot.



Grant Street -Clearing litter and debris from a vacant lot that will be maintained by the city



Mowing Season

Grass and weed enforcement season will begin April 15th. I have been preparing landlords and property owners by sending out early reminders of the City's Weed and Grass Ordinance. Letters and emails have been sent to property owners who have had previous complaints from neighbors and open violations the previous year, in hopes there will be fewer problem properties as the season progresses.

Pending Court Cases

There are currently 4 properties that have open violations in Municipal Court. All cases are classified as criminal; a minor misdemeanor is a "fine only" offence with a maximum fine of \$150. The 4th Degree Misdemeanors carry a maximum sentence of 30 days in jail and a \$250 fine, and the 3rd Degree Misdemeanors carry a maximum sentence of 60 days in jail and a \$500 fine.
