The Clinton County Landbank, with assistance from the Clinton County Prosecutor's Office, was recently able to obtain a property located at 589 N. Mulberry Street. This property has been in foreclosure for several years and has been on the caseload since 2020. The Landbank also recently received funding to complete the demolition of 3 properties within city limits. That project has been awarded to a bidder.

Assisting Other Departments



Code Enforcement was called in to assist the Wilmington Police Department in a difficult case with multiple interior violations. The condition of the interior of the rental home was one of the worst that department has witnessed. I was able to inspect the entire structure and condemn the property within hours. Several animals were also removed due to the uninhabitable conditions, special thanks to the Clinton County Humane Society and the Clinton County Dog Warden for assisting. I am moving forward with the open violations and compelling the property owner to make the critical repairs as soon as possible.

Littering Violations

After receiving a complaint that there had been trash and debris dumped on city property, I investigated an area near the County Fairgrounds. As I inspected the area, I found a large amount of discarded trash, which also included three pieces of mail with names and an address. I passed this information and the results of my investigation on to the Clinton County Sheriff's Office who followed up with the case. A suspect has since been charged with littering and will be arraigned in Municipal Court on August 2nd. Thanks to the Sheriff's Department for assisting me with this incident.
