

**ORDINANCE NO. O-17-13**

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PRESENT AN ANNUAL REPORT OF UTILITY BILLING RATES TO THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, The City of Wilmington desires to foster open, transparent, and efficient governance; and

WHEREAS, The Council of Wilmington, Ohio, has determined it in the best interest of the City and its citizens to annually review utility billing rates.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. The Service Director shall report in writing to the legislative authority, no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April of each year, a report outlining current utility billing rates, future projects, and rate recommendations for the enterprise departments, including, but not limited to, Water, Wastewater, and Sanitation Departments.

Section 2. This Service Director's annual report shall be placed on an agenda for a meeting of each enterprise department's council committee no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July of the same year.


Section 3. Each of the council committees for the enterprise departments included in the report shall issue recommendations on future utility billing rates to full council no later than the first council meeting in August of the same year.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


