

RESOLUTION NO. R-16-49

AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SPLASH PARK AT DAVID WILLIAMS MEMORIAL PARK IN WILMINGTON, OHIO

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington desires to construct a Splash Park for enjoyment and use by all members of the community and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the financial assistance has been approved for the project through a variety of entities, including the Land and Water Conservation Fund, Natureworks Grant Program and others; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service, Brian A. Shidaker has determined that said Splash Park Project is ready for the advertising for bids for the construction of the Splash Park and for beginning construction of the same.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the Splash Park in accordance with specifications to be promulgated therefore and within the appropriations therefore, the total cost estimated to exceed the sum of \$50,000.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to contract for the construction of the said Splash Park with the lowest and best bidder thereof after advertisement for such bids for not less than two (2) consecutive weeks in the Wilmington News Journal, a newspaper of general circulation within the City.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its inhabitants due to the necessity to adhere to project timelines, and accordingly, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.


