

RESOLUTION NO. R-17-26

ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington submitted an initial application in February of 2017 to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) for funds to expand and enhance the curbside recycling program;


WHEREAS, OEPA has accepted that application and committed to provide assistance for Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) to implement the project detailed in the City's application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed on behalf of the City to execute documents and take other actions as necessary to accept and administer funds from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency in the amount of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand dollars (\$250,000.00).



This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City, the emergency being the immediate need to submit the necessary paperwork by the May 19, 2017 deadline, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
