

RESOLUTION NO. R-18-34

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A STORMWATER PARTNERSHIP (SWP) SHARED REVENUE AND EXPENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON AND WOOLPERT, INC. AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WOOLPERT

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington has an extensive storm sewer network managing stormwater runoff through the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is responsible for costs associated with operations and maintenance of this storm sewer network; and

WHEREAS, currently all stormwater management program costs are supported through the Wastewater/Sewer Fund;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to implement a stormwater utility in order to fund operation and maintenance, stormwater capital improvement projects, and other costs associated with maintaining compliance with EPA-mandated requirements relative to the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) stormwater permit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington, Ohio has been in discussion with Woolpert, Inc. relative to a stormwater partnership shared revenue and expense program as an efficient and cost-effective way to implement a storm water utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That support is hereby declared for a Stormwater Partnership (SWP) Shared Revenue and Expense Agreement between the City of Wilmington and Woolpert, Inc.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to execute any document related to said agreement and to provide all information and documentation required to enter into the SWP Shared Revenue and Expense Agreement.


Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
