

RESOLUTION NO. R-18-42

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ONE TIME BONUS TO WILMINGTON TRANSIT SYSTEM EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The City of Wilmington has in its employ a great number of valuable individuals and seeks to reward said individuals for their continued contribution to the success of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Wilmington may, from time to time, appropriate funds in the form of bonuses to show its appreciation for the said continued contributions of the City's many valued employees

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council for the City of Wilmington, Ohio, hereby grants and authorizes the Director of the Wilmington Transit System Department, Anthony Morris:, at his lawful discretion, to provide the following described bonuses to all non-union employees under the supervision of said Department Head and currently employed by the City of Wilmington at the time of the passing of the within resolution: **A one-time lump sum payment of 250.00 US Dollars.**

Section 2. City Council further resolves to approve any supplemental appropriation, transfer or otherwise that is deemed necessary to properly and fully fund the distribution of said bonuses on or before the 31st day of December, 2018.

Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Wilmington and that the rules requiring the reading of this Resolution in its entirety on three separate days are hereby suspended and the within resolution shall go into effect immediately upon passage by the Legislative Council of the City of Wilmington, upon a vote of three-fourths of the members of council.
