

**RESOLUTION NO. R-18-46**

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR CLEAN OHIO TRAILS FUND GRANTS AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE CLINTON COUNTY TRAILS COALITION

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Recreation Trails Program (RTP) and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF); and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington desires financial assistance under the Clean Ohio Trails Program to help fund an extension of the Luther Warren Peace Path; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO,

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Wilmington approves filing applications for Clean Ohio Trails Fund financial assistance.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute and file applications with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Wilmington and the Clinton County Trails Coalition to develop a shared-use trail for public benefit, attached hereto and incorporated herein as **“Exhibit A.”**

Section 4. That the City of Wilmington does agree to obligate funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Clean Ohio Trails Fund Program.

Section 5. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
