

RESOLUTION NO. R-19-19

AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION CLEAN OHIO FUNDS - GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION GRANT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Clean Ohio Fund – Green Space Conservation Program of the Ohio Public Works Commission, administers financial assistance for green space preservation and improvements for recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington Service Director desires financial assistance under the Green Space Conservation Program to fund an extension of the Luther Warren Peace Path from Nelson Avenue to Ogden Road; and

WHEREAS, the project name on the application to the Clean Ohio Fund – Green Space Conservation Program is “Lytle Creek Greenway Project.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilmington, Ohio,

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Wilmington approves filing the application for financial assistance for the Lytle Creek Greenway Project.

Section 2. That the Service Director is hereby authorized to execute and file an application with the Ohio Public Works Commission and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3. That the City of Wilmington does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for financial aid under the terms of the Clean Ohio Conservation Program.

Section 4. That the City of Wilmington will use the value of land to be donated, as well as funds appropriated toward the project pursuant to House Bill No. 529, the 132nd General Assembly of the State of Ohio, to provide a 50% local match.

Section 5. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its inhabitants due to the necessity to adhere to project timelines, and accordingly, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
